

Full fees for each semester must be settled before the semester begins.

In alignment with Springfield's commitment to equitable access and procedural clarity, the University introduced a flexible **Payment Plan Schedule** to assist students who faced challenges in settling full tuition fees prior to enrolment. This initiative was designed as a **support mechanism**, not an entitlement.

Policy Statement

Every student is **required to select** one of the approved payment plans: **Monthly, Quarterly, Per Semester, or Annual**.

The **monthly plan** is a facilitative option—not a right—and does **not extend beyond 11 months**, nor does it override the principle of pre-semester clearance. The Monthly Plan runs from January to November; the Quarterly Plan aligns with January, April, July, and October; the Semester Plan corresponds to February and August; and the Annual Plan may commence in either January or August.

Students who fail to meet their selected plan's obligations may face **registration delays, academic access restrictions, or financial penalties**, as outlined in the University's Financial Code.

The University will continue to model best practice in sovereign education, and students are expected to uphold the same standard.
